

## **Results of the Project WILD Survey -- 1990: North Carolina**

### **1990**

Surveys distributed through North Carolina environmental education newsletter.

Informal tool to determine if Project WILD is being used in North Carolina, how it is being used, who is using it, and how the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission can augment or support its use by educators.

Majority of respondents from grades K-8.

Project WILD is held in high esteem by survey respondents.

Vast majority use Project WILD as a part of their curriculum, however, most use no more than 10 activities in a year.

Almost all respondents felt Project WILD was easy to use and provides a balanced approach.

Some felt they needed more support from their administrators or supervisors to use Project WILD.

Many are doing action projects (61%), but a good number are not. Guidance or support for action projects is warranted.

Additional supplementary materials are requested. More workshops are in high demand. (Especially on special topics -- some specific to North Carolina.)
