

## **Montana Project WILD Survey Results**

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Written surveys were sent to educators who had attended Project WILD workshops. 233 were sent out and 131 were returned.

The majority of the respondents had read most of the Project WILD activity guide.

45% of the teachers shared the book with other teachers

An overwhelming percent of educators used Project WILD for activities to stimulate interest.

96% of respondents agreed that the activity guide had increased their general knowledge of wildlife and increased their interest in environmental education.

96% of respondents felt the activity guide contained the type of information desirable for classroom activities.

When asked how the activity guide could be more helpful, respondents indicated:

- expansion of activities
- add a bibliography
- provide handouts, visual aids, films, and "hands-on" materials

96% indicated they would like to receive additional content information about Montana's fish and wildlife resource.

79% plan to use Project WILD as a supplement to the present curriculum and as a additional resource to a study unit already presented.

Teachers indicated that they would like more and longer workshops.
