

Project WILD Aquatic (K-6 Aquatic Education Program) Research Summary

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Survey completed in fall of 1993

Random sample of individuals who had been trained in past workshops.

Survey respondents (95%) indicated that the materials provided adequate background material to teach the activities to students and over half the respondents (56%) indicated they felt the materials could be used without training.

98% indicated the Project WILD Aquatic manual was easy to understand and 97% indicated it was easy to implement.

97% of the respondents had used the materials. 73% had used them with students six or more hours; 49% had used them ten or more hours.

Used in the following areas: Science/Math 81%; Social Studies 74%; Reading/Language Arts 70%; Art 70%. Materials are truly multidisciplinary.

Teachers tended to attend workshops based on personal interest.

82% of educators work with students between 6 and 13 years of age.

Approximately 50% of participants did 6 or more Project WILD activities.
